Engagement with Play

21st Dec

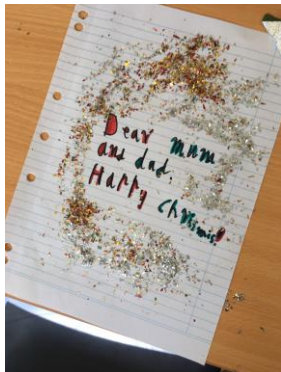
OSHClub Two-week shutdown period commences. No OSHClub services will be operating during this time, Customer accounts will still be operating (except on the Public Holidays).

POLICY CORNER

Delivery and Collection of Children Policy

The safety of children attending OSHClub is our highest priority. When collecting or dropping off your child, please ensure you come right up to the OSHC room and check with an educator that your child has been signed in or out. Even while we are restricting families into the OSHC room, we are still checking IDs (where appropriate) and ensuring your child is kept safe whilst in our care. This is in accordance with the National Regulations.

Reminders

At least 7 days' notice is required for cancellation of a Vacation Care booking to ensure you will not incur out of pocket costs. Cancellations within this period can still be made, however they will be marked as an absence, and you will incur a charge for the session.
